


ROUTE DESCRIPTION

- R and L represent sides of the river while facing downstream.
- 0.0 (R) Confluence with Rainy River.**
- 0.5 (L) Reedy Flats Landing.** Trailer access, toilet and watercraft camping on the upstream side of the Highway 11 bridge.
- 4.5 Power line crossing.**
- 9.0 (R) Ivan Crawford Landing trailer access.** Just off County Road 10. Confluence with Bear River.
- 10.2-11.7 (L) Waldbilig Wildlife Management Area.**
- 19.0 (R) County Road 1 bridge/Lofgren Landing carry-in access.** Town of Lindford.
- 21.7 Powerline crossing.**
- 30.4 (R) Keuffner's Landing.** Carry-in access, toilets and watercraft campsite.
- 34.2 (R) Gowdy Landing carry-in access and watercraft campsite.** Hendrickson Landing.
- 39.8-41.3 Class I rapids.**
- 43.0 (R) Ben Linn Landing.** A grassy clearing with a watercraft campground and carry-in access.
- 45.5 (L) Confluence with Ostby Creek.**
- 47.5 (L) Sturgeon River Landing.** Carry-in access and watercraft campground, just above the confluence with the Sturgeon River.
- 52.0-8 Rapids, class IV.** Half-mile mile portage (L).
- 52.7 (R) Cody Landing trailer access.**
- 52.6 (L) Big Falls City Park.** Campground, rest area toilet and drinking water.
- 52.8 Railroad bridge with river level gauge.**
- 53.0 (L) Big Falls East Landing.** Trailer access. The beginning of a half-mile portage around Big Falls, which is a series of four falls dropping 40 feet in a quarter mile, rated Class IV. Cross the river via Highway 71 Bridge. Put in at trailer access west of Highway 71 below the falls on river right.
- 53.8 Location of old CCC Camp.**
- 61.0 (L) Grunwald Landing carry-in access.**
- 65.2 (R) Confluence with Macaffee Brook.**
- 67.5 (L) Johnson Landing.** Carry-in access. Rest area near shore and watercraft campsite.
- 68.5 R) Confluence with Reilly Creek.**
- 72.2 (R) Confluence with Reilly Brook.**
- 72.6 Power line crossing.**
- 75.8 (L) Highway 6 (N) carry-in access and bridge.**
