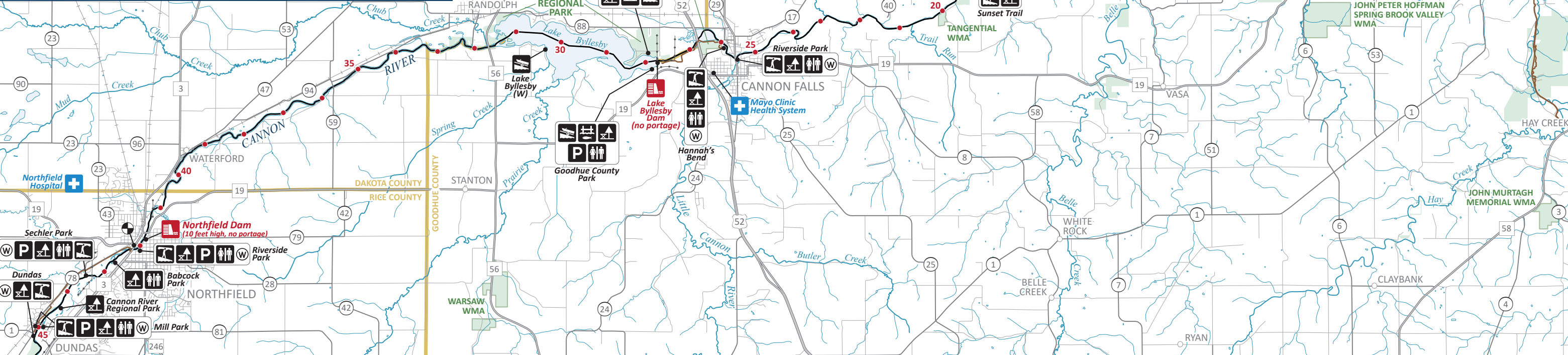


CANNON RIVER STATE WATER TRAIL

Route Description

R and L represent sides of the river facing downstream.

CANNON RIVER RM 46 to MISSISSIPPI RIVER

- 45.2 (L) Dundas City Park. Carry-in access, rest area, picnic shelter, tables, drinking water, and fire rings. Cannon River Aquatic Management Area.
- 45.0 Mill Park. At (L) Rest area, restrooms, drinking water. Carry-in access at (R). County Road 1 bridge. The river splits around a large island. Town of Dundas, Archibald Mill.
- 44.4 (R) Cannon River Regional Park. Rest area.
- 43.6 Mill Towns State Trail parallels river here.
- 43.5 (L) Sechler City Park. Carry-in access, picnic shelter, restrooms and drinking water.
- 43.3 Powerline crossing.
- 42.7 (R) Babcock City Park. Rest area and restrooms.
- 42.1 (R) Riverside City Park. Carry-in access just above Highway 3 bridge, restrooms, rest area, drinking

- Lake Byllesby Dam. 60 feet high, no portage.
- Powerline crossing.
- Highway 52 bridge. Gemini Aquatic Management Area.

- Sunset Trail carry-in access. Rest area.
- Meisville Ravine County Park Reserve. Carry-in and rest area. Confluence with Trout Brook. Powerline crossing.
- Powerline crossing.
- River splits around a large island.
- Rest area. River level gauge.
- County Road 7 bridge. Outfitter at Welch.

- Cannon Bottom Road bridge. This site is the last takeout before the Mississippi River. (not a developed access)
- Powerline crossing.
- Canadian Pacific Railroad bridge.
- Confluence with the Mississippi River.
