

Route Description

R and L represent sides of the river facing downstream.

CANNON RIVER RM 46 to MISSISSIPPI RIVER

- 45.2 (L) Dundas City Park. Carry-in access, rest area, picnic shelter, tables, drinking water, and fire rings. Cannon River Aquatic Management Area.
- 45.0 Mill Park. At (L) Rest area, restrooms, drinking water. Carry-in access at (R). County Road 1 bridge. The river splits around a large island. Town of Dundas, Archibald Mill.
- Cannon River Regional Park. Rest area. 44.4 (R)
- Mill Towns State Trail parallels river here. 43.6
- 43.5 (L) Sechler City Park. Carry-in access, picnic shelter, restrooms and drinking water.
- Powerline crossing. 43.3
- Babcock City Park. Rest area and restrooms. 42.7 (R)
- Riverside City Park. Carry-in access just above 42.1 (R) Highway 3 bridge, restrooms, rest area, drinking

- water. River level gauge.
- 41.9 5th Street bridge.
- 41.9 Northfield Dam. 10 feet high; no developed portage. 4th/Water Streets bridge.
- 41.8 Highway 19 (2nd Street) bridge.
- 41.1 Powerline crossing.
- 39.5 (L) Town of Waterford.
- Canada Avenue bridge. 38.5
- County Road 59 bridge. 35.8
- 32.2 Remnants of Cascade Mill Dam can be seen.
- Highway 56 bridge. Enter Lake Byllesby. 31.8
- 30.2 (R) Lake Byllesby (W) trailer access.
- Goodhue County Park. Trailer access, restroom, 27.8 (L) rest area and fishing pier.
- Lake Byllesby Regional Park. Trailer access, rest 27.8 (L) area, campsites, restrooms and drinking water.
- Lake Byllesby Dam. 60 feet high, no portage. 27.8 (R) Powerline crossing.
- 27.5 26.8
 - Highway 52 bridge. Gemini Aquatic Management Area.

- 26.0 **9th Street bridge.**
- 25.9 (R) Hannah's Bend Park and Fairground. Carry-in access, restrooms, picnic shelter and drinking water. Managed by Cannon Falls. 25.5 (R) Riverside City Park. Little Cannon River.
 - Carry-in access, restrooms, drinking water. Highway 20 bridge. 3rd Street bridge.
- 25.4 24.0
 - Mill Towns State Trail bridge crossing.
- 22.9 (L) Confluence with Pine Creek. Confluence with Trail Run.
- 20.8 (R)
 - Tangential Wildlife Mangement Area. 20.0 (R)
 - Sunset Trail carry-in access. Rest area. 19.1 (R)
 - Meisville Ravine County Park Reserve. Carry-in 18.5 (L) and rest area. Confluence with Trout Brook. Powerline crossing. Powerline crossing.
- 18.0 River splits around a large island. 16.5
- Rest area. River level gauge. 13.6 (R)

 - County Road 7 bridge. Outfitter at Welch.

6.1	Cannon Bottom Road bridge. This site is the last takeout before the Mississippi River. (not a developed access)
3.4	Powerline crossing.
2.6	Canadian Pacific Railroad bridge.
