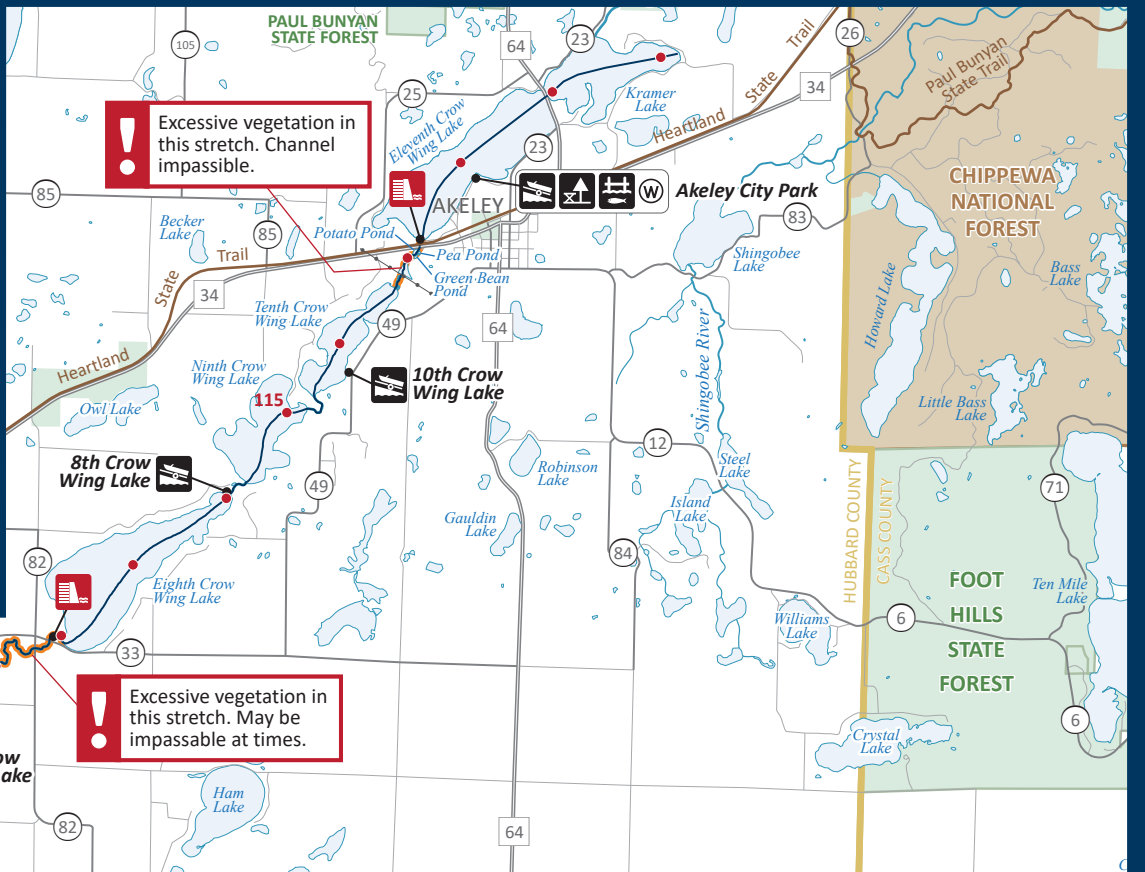
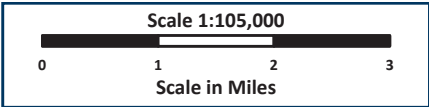


CROW WING RIVER STATE WATER TRAIL

Route Description, RM 120 to 65

R and L represent sides of the river facing downstream

- 119.0 Highway 64. Mostly lake paddling to the south end of 5th Crow Wing Lake.
- 118.0 Akeley City Park. Access to Eleventh Crow Wing Lake. Trailer access, fishing pier, campground, drinking water and rest area.
- 117.2 (L) Dam. Portage left 25 yards around a small dam where the lake joins with the Crow Wing River. River channel is narrow, may be impassible between lakes.
- 117.0 Heartland State Trail Bridge. The river flows under the Heartland State Trail trestle, then through a culvert under Highway 34 into a marshy area.
- 116.8 Powerline crossing.
- 115.8 (L) 10th Crow Wing Lake trailer access.
- 114.1 (R) 8th Crow Wing Lake trailer access.
- 111.9 (R) Dam. Portage right 75 yards over County Road 33 (use caution crossing the road). River channel is narrow in this next stretch and may be overgrown with vegetation after June and may be impassible. Scout before paddling.
- 109.5 County Road 13 bridge. River paddling along this stretch. 7th Crow Wing Carry-in access located on river left at County Road 13.
- 107.6 6th Crow Wing Lake trailer access. On lake's south end.
- 105.1 Dam. Portage right 75 yards over Township Road 28 (use caution crossing the road). Primarily lake paddling to this point. Respect private property. Powerline crossing.
- 105 to 100 "Wilderness" Section. River paddling downstream from the dam. The next 5 miles of river paddling are in a beautiful wilderness setting, with only a few riverfront cabins.
- 100.5 County Road 13 bridge.
- 98.2 (L) Two lake trailer accesses. Located on the west bank of 3rd and east bank of the 4th Crow Wing Lakes.
- 95.6 Highway 87 bridge. Intermittent river and lake paddling to next portage.
- 94.5-88 Crow Wing Chain Wildlife Management Area.
- 92.0 Powerline crossing.
- 89.7 (L) Rock Dam/1st Crow Wing Lake trailer access. County Road 109, under bridge, rock dam/portage. Experienced paddlers may scout first, then pass through. Others should portage left 65 yards over County Road 109 (use caution crossing the road). 1 mile downstream from the 1st Crow Wing Lake.
- 88.9 Powerline crossing.
- 88.2 (R) Confluence with the Shell River.
- 85.0 (L) Tree Farm Landing. Carry-in access, rest area, watercraft/walk-in campsites, toilet, drinking water, camping (fee), Wadena Co. administered.*
- 82.6 (L) County Road 18 bridge. Huntersville (N) carry-in access, town of Huntersville.
- 81.1 (L) Huntersville (S) carry-in access.
- 79.8 (R) Big Bend watercraft campsites. Huntersville State Forest, no road access.
- 78.6 (R) Casey's Landing trailer access.
- 77.6 (R) Huntersville #4 carry-in access. Drinking water, rest area, toilets, camping, watercraft campsite.
- 75.3 (R) Mary Brown Rest Area. Carry-in access, County Road 15 bridge.
- 71.0 Walkin's Rapids. Class I, may go to Class II at high river levels.
- 70.8 (R) Anderson's Crossing. Carry-in access, watercraft/walk-in campsites, water, camping (fee), rest area, toilets. Wadena Co. administered.*
- 68.3 Burrows Rapids. Class I.
- 67.4 (L) Confluence with Big Swamp Creek.
- 67.3-66.5 Westra Rapids. Class I, may go to Class II at high river levels.
- 65.7 (R) Stigman's Mound. Carry-in access, rest area, toilet. County Road 139 bridge, city of Nimrod. Start of Highway 227. River level gauge.
