

# ROUTE DESCRIPTION

**NOTE:** (R) and (L) represent right and left banks of the river when facing downstream.

**RIVER MILE:**

- 57.4** Pine Mountain Lake Dam. No established portage. Backus trailer access on east end of lake. Rest area and toilets. **Be alert for multiple box culverts, low culverts and dams in this area. Use caution, some may require portaging.**
- 57.4-46** Highway 87 Culverts/Luce Line State Trail bridge. No established portage.
- 57.1** Highway 371 low culverts. No established portage.
- 56.1** Enter Bowen Lake; Dam north end. No established portage. Trailer access south end.
- 54.9** Township Road low culverts. Use caution.
- 53.8 (L)** Lind Lake trailer access.
- 50.2** County Road 42 box culverts. No established portage.
- 46.5** Enter Lake Hattie; Dam at east end. No established portage.
- 45.9** Lake Hattie Drive low bridge. No established portage.
- 44.9 (L)** Confluence with Lizzie Creek.
- 44.8** Ding Pot Swamp. High grass, channel may be hard to find.
- 43.8** Powerline crossing.
- 41.7** Barclay Township Road 4. Low bridge, use caution, portage (R), 20 yards.

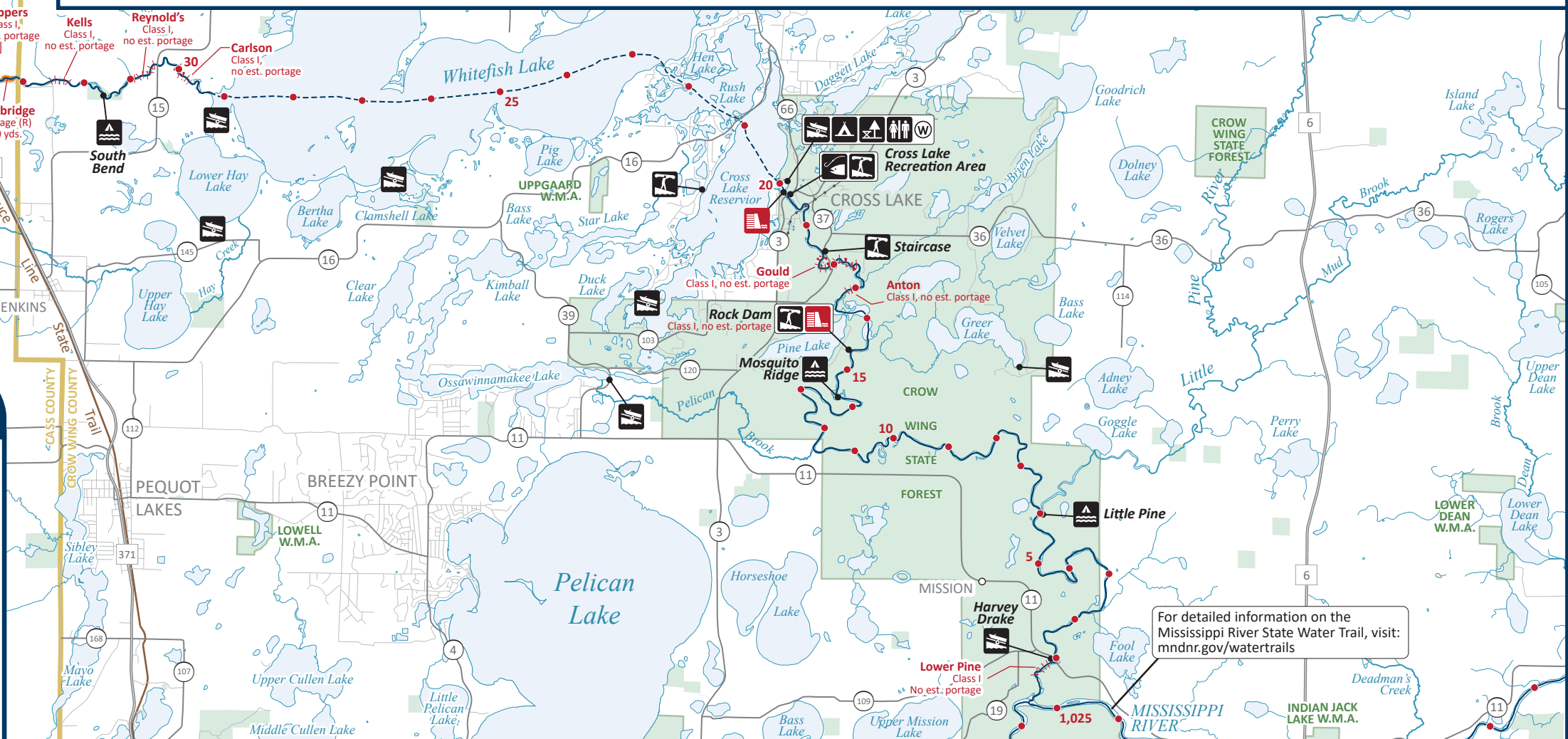
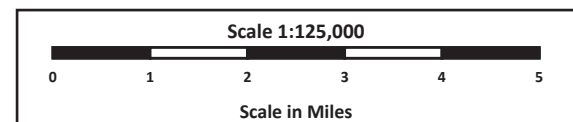
- 38.5 (R)** Norway Lake South carry-in access. There is also a trailer access on the north side.
- 38.3 (R)** #1 carry-in access and fishing pier. City of Pine River.
- 37.6** Former Dam Site. Class I, portage right, 20 yards. Short stretch of rapids
- 36.8** Highway 371/Luce Line State Trail bridge.
- 36.6-36.1** Gromek Rapids. Class I, no established portage.
- 35.7 (R)** Confluence with the South Fork of the Pine River.
- 35.6 (L)** Watercraft campsite
- 34.5 (L)** Confluence with Arvig Creek. Highway 371/Luce Line State Trail bridge.
- 34-33.7** Hopper's Rapids. Class I, no established portage.
- 33.3** Hopper's bridge crossing. Low bridge, use caution, portage right, 20 yards.
- 32.5-32.2** Kell's Rapids. Class I, no portage. Old bridge pilings in river, use caution.
- 31.6 (R)** South Bend watercraft campsite.
- 31-30.5** Reynold's Rapids. Class I, no established portage. County Road 15 bridge at mile 30.5.
- 30-29.7** Carlson Rapids. Class I, no established portage.
- 29.0** Beginning of the Whitefish Chain. Next 9 miles, large waves, heavy boat traffic. The best route is to follow the shoreline.
- 29.0** South Delta Bay Landing trailer access.
- 26.5 (R)** Trailer access. South end of Clamshell Lake.
- 21.1** County Road 16 bridge.
- 19.9-8** Cross Lake Federal Recreation Area and Dam. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, portage

- 19.7** Campground and trailer access. (Fee for overnight camping.)
- 19.5** Dam on SE corner of Cross Lake Reservoir. Carry-in and shorefishing just below the dam.
- 18.5 (L)** County Road 3 bridge.
- 18.4-17.6** Powerline crossing.
- 18.0** Staircase Landing carry-in access.
- 17.0-16.8** Gould Rapids. Class I, no established portage.
- 15.3** County Road 36 bridge.
- 14.5 (R)** Anton Rapids. Class I, no established portage.
- 11.7 (R)** Rock riffles. Depending on water levels, portaging may be required. No established portage.
- 6.0 (L)** Mosquito Ridge Watercraft Campsite.
- 0.9 (R)** Confluence with Pelican Brook.
- 0.9** Confluence with Little Pine River. Little Pine Watercraft Campsite.
- 0.8-0.5** Harvey Drake Landing trailer access.
- 0.0** County Road 11 bridge. River level gauge south end of bridge.
- 0.0** Lower Pine Rapids. Class I, no established portage.
- 0.0** Confluence with Mississippi River at river mile 1024.6. 20 river miles upstream of Brainerd.
