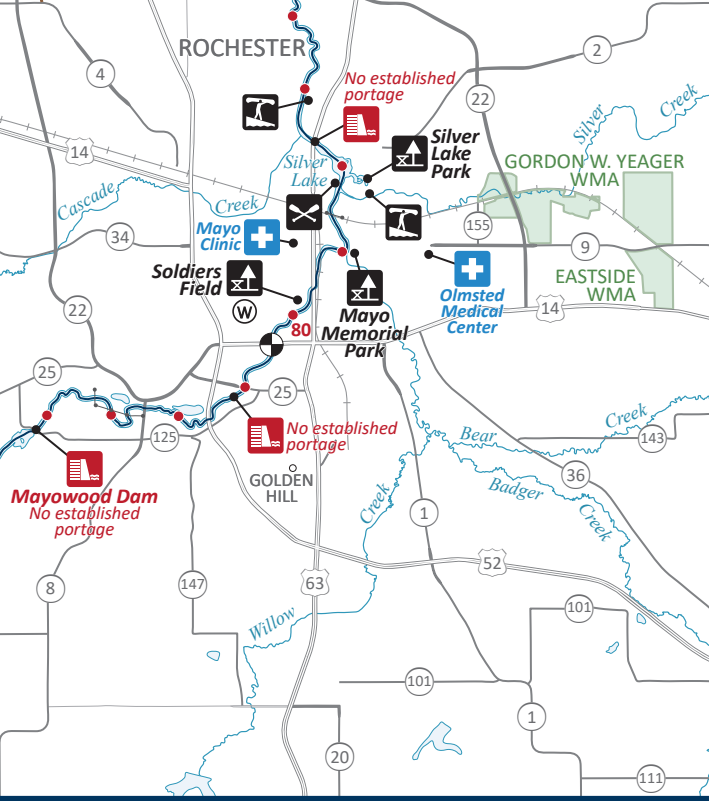
- 80.5 (L) Collins Park: Toilets and drinking water. City of Pine Island
