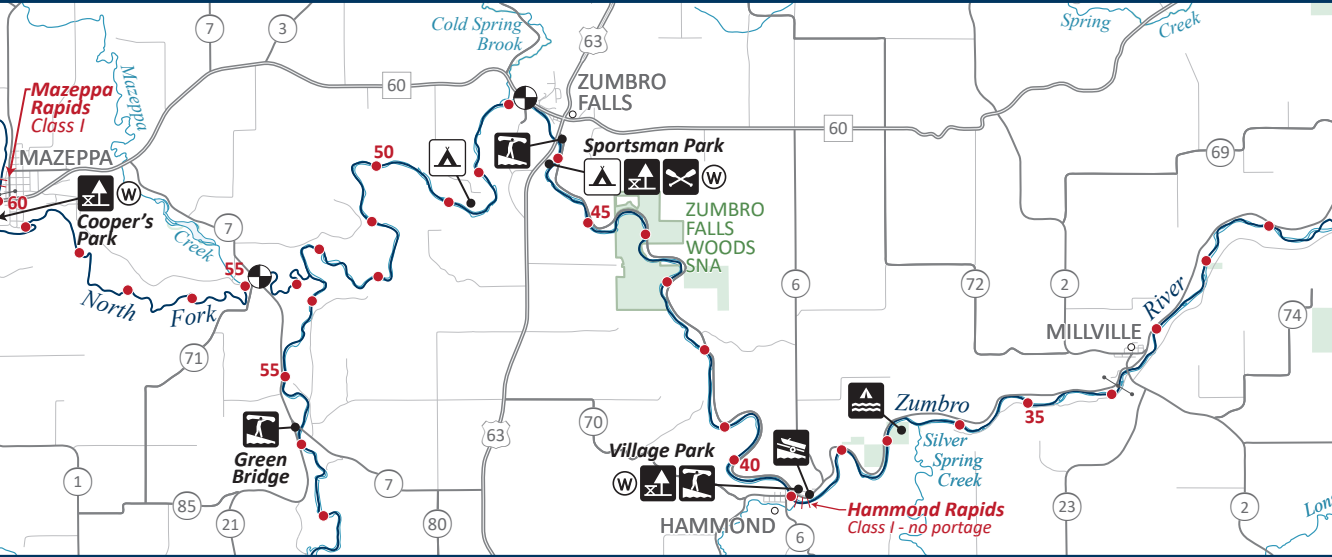

- 55 Township road bridge. Confluence with Mazeppa Creek downstream (L).
- 54.8 Co. Road 7 bridge.
- 53.5 Zumbro River confluence.

#### ZUMBRO RIVER

- 55.8 (L) Green Bridge: carry-in access.
- 53.5 (L) North Fork Zumbro River confluence.
- 48.2 (L) Private campground.
- 47 (L) Cold Spring Brook confluence.

#### WHITEWATER RIVER

- 16.4 Co. Highway 26 bridge. Carry-in access downstream of the bridge (R).
- 16 (R) South Fork of the Whitewater River confluence.
- 10.2 (L) Carry-in access.
- 10.2 (L) **Caution:** rock weirs and rapids downstream of the bridge.
- 6.4 Rock weir - 2 foot plus drop.
- 4.2 Rock weir - 2 foot plus drop.
- 1.2 Power line crossing.
- 0.5 Snowmobile bridge. Carry-in access (R).
- 0.5 US Highway 61 bridge. Railroad trestle.
- 0 Mississippi River confluence.
